Nordic Global Compact Meeting 2021 – FAQ

Where do I register for the conference?

[Click here](#) to register for the conference. You can mark whether you will be attending physically in Nuuk or online. For online participants, links and practical information will follow later.

How do I get to Nuuk?

Flights are going to Nuuk from Copenhagen on November 9 and back again on November 12. Alternatively, there are flights from Reykjavik to Nuuk on November 8 with Icelandair. Please go to [Air Greenland](#) or [Icelandair](#) to find exact itineraries.

Do I need to go to Copenhagen to take the flight with the group?

You can only get to Greenland via Iceland or Copenhagen. Hence, you will need to make your way to one of those two destinations.

How can I book flights and hotel?

Bookings at discounted rates for flights and rooms can be made through [Travel by Heart](#). Alternatively, you can book directly via www.airgreenland.com or www.icelandair.com for flights and either Hotel Hans Egede's own website or one of the booking sites (booking.com, Airbnb.com or similar) for hotel.

What is the price range of flights and hotels?

Prices for a return ticket with Air Greenland from Copenhagen start at DKK 4500.

Where will the meeting take place?

The meeting will take place online and physically at Hotel Hans Egede: Aqqusinersuaq 1-3, Nuuk, 3900, Greenland

Where is the accommodation situated?

The main hotel will be our conference venue Hotel Hans Egede and the sister hotel, Hotel Hans Egede Express. There are also multiple options for Airbnb. Nuuk is a small town, so the venue and restaurants are within walking distance if you are not staying at Hotel Hans Egede.

Which expenses are at my own cost?

Flights, accommodation, meals (apart from breakfast and lunch on both conference days), the points under "Additional Program" and any other activities you might be interested in outside the planned conference days will be at your own cost. The conference and food during the conference is free.

How many can we attend from one company/organization?

We kindly ask you to limit the number of attendees per company to two people.

How do I get around in Nuuk?

Taxis are available from the airport to hotels (approx. DKK 125 - 140), credit cards accepted. Please note that there are no public transportation options from the airport. Once in town, you can walk everywhere.

When is the deadline for booking of flights and hotels?

Flights are limited, so we recommend to book well in advance. There is no deadline as such.

How do I sign up for the Additional Program (company visits, tours, informal dinners, northern lights tour) and what is the price?

Will our travel expenses be reimbursed if the physical conference is cancelled because of a possible worsening of the pandemic?

In the case of cancelling the Nordic Networks will not be able to reimburse your travel expenses. However, in case of restrictions in Greenland, Hotel Hans Egede and Air Greenland will provide refunds.
